Can you make a shelter?
 - You may need adult help for this. Choose a place: in the garden, the park or even inside in room. Use tree branches, rope, old blankets and natural materials to help. Pretend you are alive 10,000 years ago and must make a place to shelter from the wind, the sun and rain - a place to sleep, to make a fire, to cook on. Can you photograph your shelter and send or print a picture to show in class?
 - Using our research of a stone age hunter write a story about a stone age hunter. Write how they lived and learned, what they looked like, how they died (or lived happily ever after?)!

- Can you use your research skills to find out about a Bronze age culture/civilisation?
 It could be the Shang Dynasty in China, the Mycenaean from Greece or the Beaker People of Britain.
 Things you need to know are: Where did they live? What were their homes like? What did they make and wear? What materials and tools did they use? What did they believe in?
 - Visit a local museum to view examples of stone, bronze and iron age artefacts. Sketch your most interesting item label it with: object and date. What is it made from? Where was it found? Why do you like it?
