

Computing

Our computing learning unit is called 'I am a wildlife presenter'.

Children will be using the i-pads to create their own short wildlife videos about living things in our environment. They will collaborate to present what they know about habitats using iMovie.



Physical Education

Year 2

Our World



IPC Topic

Children will begin with a topic called 'Brainwaves' which explores how we learn. They will discuss the difference between 'knowledge', 'skills' and 'understanding' and how this affects their learning.

In week 2, children will begin their next IPC topic 'Our World', which will focus on the environment and life cycles.

In Art we will be creating impressions of landscapes using natural materials instead of conventional media.

In Science we will learn about basic conditions needed for living things to survive, and create bird feeders, for the school grounds.



Reading

To help foster a true love for reading, we are reinvigorating our reading records for this academic year. All pupils will now have their very own 'Reading Journal'. This will accompany their in class learning as children continue with SFA or RWI this term. The children are working on increasing fluency, using inference and presenting and justifying opinions. Accelerated Reader tests will continue to motivate pupils to read for comprehension.



Mathematics

During our maths lessons this term we will be learning:


- Place value of numbers up to 100.
- To compare and order numbers from 0 to 100.
- To recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently.

In these units of work, children will be expected to apply their learning of addition and subtraction to solve problems.

As a summative activity, every Friday we will compete in a "Beat That" maths challenge, to test our knowledge of number facts.

Writing

To celebrate Roald Dahl's 100th Birthday, we will be reading 'The Magic Finger' during Writing Weeks. Children will learn to retell the story using actions, pictures, puppets and technology. Once we are familiar with the story, we will reimagine the text and compose our own version of the story.
