## IPC Topic

## Reading

Children will be continuing with their SFA or RWI class during this half term. The children are working on increasing fluency, using inference and presenting and justifying opinions.

Accelerated Reader tests can be taken throughout the week. We recommend children read their book at least twice, once for fluency and a second time for understanding.



## Writing

This term children will continue to learn to use features of fiction writing to write their own stories. The stories they write will be linked to our IPC topic.

The final week of term will be focused on poetry. Children will read and learn a variety of poems and then write their own using the same techniques.






## Mathematics
