#### Reading

We will be starting our Read Write Inc. classes and Daily Supported Reading later in the term.

Book bags should be brought to school every day and the children's books will be changed on Wednesdays and Fridays. Please read, discuss and re-read the books sent home. Please comment and sign in your child's Reading journal Book twice a week.

## Writing

The Enormous Crocodile by Roald Dahl will be the focus text for Year One during Writing Weeks which will run for the first three weeks of term. Children will learn to retell the story using actions, pictures and puppets to help them. Once children are familiar with the story they will create their own versions of the book.

We will focus on story writing. We will learn about patterns in stories and learn how to write our own stories with a beginning, middle and an end.

#### **Mathematics**

In the Autumn term we will be focusing on the numbers 1—10.

Children will learn to form their numbers correctly and to confidently sequence their numbers—counting forward and back. They will explore number bonds up to 10.

We will be introducing children to the +, - and = signs and what they mean. Children will be able to apply their knowledge of number bonds to solve addition and subtraction equations confidently.

#### How can you help me at home?

Help me practise my times tables at speed. By the end of the term children should be confident with their 2 times tables.

Help me practise my spellings. Spelling will happen every Monday and Friday.

Read with me every night and comment in my Reading Journal twice a week.
