IPC Topic

In Geography, we will learn to read different types of maps to locate Great Britain and Brazil - our home and host countries.

We will learn how to use the Internet, atlases, photos and graphs to locate geographical information and key facts.

We will learn to describe our local area and present information in teams using i-books, Google Earth and posters.

In Science, we will be learning ways to think up scientific questions and find out about the animals of the Brazilian rainforest. We will be making holiday themed art using chalk and photography.

Reading

Book bags should be brought in every day. The children's books will be changed on Thursdays. Please read, discuss and re-read the books sent home.

Please also write the date and any comments in your child's Reading Record Book.

Daily Supported Reading will take place each day. Children are learning to select books independently and take Accelerated Reader quizzes.

Mathematics

Every day, we will practise mental recall of number facts. We will be tested on these in our 'fun' weekly 'Beat That' tests at school and practise these for home learning too.

In our Maths Meetings, we will practise telling the time and identifying the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

We will learn about the value of money, recognising different coins and notes. We will practise how to solve problems involving money.

We will begin to explore multiplication and division using grouping and sharing.

Writing

We will learn to write recounts and reports. We will write a recount about our sports day, ordering and describing the events and results, as well as describing the tension and excitement!

We will also learn how to write our own non-chronological report including facts about the animals of the Amazon Rainforest.

We will have handwriting lessons four times a week to practise our cursive handwriting.
