We will focus on using Padlet to help us enhance our questioning skills linked to Art and Design, and also a Curiosity Challenge.



Physical Education

Year 3

Gateways to the World



IPC Topic

Our topic is Gateways to the World, which will focus on Airports. In Geography, we will focus on the connections we have with different places in the world. This unit will require research into jobs in an airport, planning an airport design and how we use maps and travel. We will learn the effect this has on the environment. In Science we will investigate which material is best for an airport runway. In Art we will be designing logos for planes and sculptures based on Leonardo DaVinci and flight.

Reading

We expect 3 comments each week in the children's reading journals.

Children will choose an Accelerated Reader book to read at school and home. Once finished, they will complete a test on iPads. Children will choose a class reader or a book of interest in other DEAR sessions.

Children will have daily SFA/RWI lessons, learning new reading and comprehension skills as well as developing co-operative learning strategies.

Mathematics

This term the children will be focusing on deepening conceptual understanding and fluency with multiplication and division with a specific focus on the six and eight times tables. Pupils will make connections between aspects of multiplication and division that they have previously come across.

Children will also consider a number of mental calculating strategies, reviewing the work they have done on mental arithmetic through the course of the year and make connections with known facts and knowledge of the four operations. This will include working with four digit numbers.

Writing

The half term will begin with planning and writing explanation texts, which are closely linked to our IPC topic.

The children will continue to develop their narrative skills and practise spelling and grammar weekly.

At the end of this term, we will complete a writing week, exploring poetry linked to Curiosity.
