

Computing

Year 5 will be incorporating digital learning across the curriculum and each Y5 child will have their own iPad to record their learning.

In addition we will have a computing lesson every Monday.



Physical Education

P.E. will continue to be taught by our specialist P.E. coaches on a Wednesday afternoon, for which the children will need to come prepared with the correct P.E kit: black shorts/tracksuit bottoms, blue top and black or white trainers. This half term children will be learning Basketball.

Now the children have completed their swimming lessons a seconds hour-long session of PE will be taught on Friday afternoons by class teachers.

Religious Education

Topic: Exploring Christian Values in the World Today.

The children will look at Christian values through the teachings of Jesus and Bible stories and how these values apply to the world today.



Spelling & Home Learning

Home learning will be sent out during the second week of each half term. Please support your children in completing at least one activity from each section.

Spellings and Maths will be given on a weekly basis and children will be tested each Monday (5B) or Tuesday (5G) on their spelling words. The children should also complete their Reading Journals each week.

Year 5

Weather and Climate



IPC Topic

Our IPC topic for the term is Weather and Climate.

One of our 3 sessions each week will be led by our specialist Art teacher, and one by the Computing team. The remaining lesson will focus primarily on Geography and the children will learn about:

- Different climate and weather patterns
- Why climate is varied
- The Water Cycle
- Climate of our host country, Indonesia

Reading

The main element of reading remains SFA (Success For All) throughout Year 5. This is taught four times a week using the appropriate Treasure Hunts.

The children will continue to read books independently for Accelerated Reader, completing their Reading Journals, and taking tests in class when they have completed a book. All children are expected to bring their reading book and Journal to school every day.



Mathematics

The following areas will be covered:

- Volume—estimating volume and capacity and Area—using cm^2 and m^2 .
- Fractions and Decimals—comparing and ordering numbers with up to 3 decimal places, rounding decimals, comparing and ordering fractions, recognising mixed numbers and improper fractions and convert between them.
- Angles—recognising and measuring obtuse, acute and reflex angles.

Writing

This half term we will be covering recount, persuasive writing and discursive genres, linked to our IPC topic.

We will continue to focus on extending and combining sentences using commas and clauses. In addition we will be extending the range of adverbials that children use to link paragraphs, and conjunctions to join sentences.
