Topic: Judaism

The children will make connections between the Jewish belief in a Creator God and the role assigned to humans in taking responsibility for others and environment.

Curriculum Information Autumn 1



Year 6

Fairgrounds



IPC Topic

- Children begin with a short topic called 'Brainwaves' which explores how we learn. Our topic is 'Fairgrounds'.
- In Science we will learn about different types of forces and how they act upon objects. We will study light and sound and how it travels.
- We will conduct science experiments using 'Fair Testing'.
- Identifying patterns in the results.
- Explaining and justifying predictions and conclusions.
- In international and society we will consider the impact of the construction of a theme park on people's lives in a rural area.

Reading

Children will participate in the Year 6 revision unit of SFA, consolidating and learning new reading and comprehension skills. Children will be sent home with an Accelerated Reader book which you should share with your child. They will take a test on their understanding when they have completed it. In addition reading journals have been issued for all children to log comments about the text they are reading.



Mathematics

This term the children will be continuing Primary Advantage Maths programme with a focus on reasoning and problem solving, to deepen their conceptual understanding of place value in numbers of up to 10,000,000 and calculations involving the four operations and negative numbers. To solve problems involving measures and time. To convert time between AM/PM/hours and minutes. Also to convert length, mass and volume from smaller to larger units and vice versa.

We will also go through some of the key mental maths strategies which are an integral part of the new maths curriculum.

Writing

We are starting the year with a Writing Week on 'Matilda' by Roald Dahl. The children will use this model to invent their own story. This half term we will be covering a variety of different genres including diary recounts, non-chronological reports, persuasive and discursive writing. We will be using whole texts to teach story writing and continuing to look at shorter texts of different non fiction types. Weekly spellings based on patterns and strategies will be linked with handwriting.
