Religious Education

They will also make connections between the Christian celebration of the Eucharist/Holy Communion and what Jesus said and did at the Last Supper. The children will also make connections between the commemoration, worship and teaching, which occur at Christian festivals, and the Bible.

Our unit this term is Healthy Me.

The children will learn about the impact of food on the body e.g. creating energy, giving comfort and altering mood.

They will also understand what it means to be emotionally well and can explore people's attitudes towards mental health/illness.

They will learn and be able to put into practice basic emergency aid procedures (e.g. the recovery position) and know how to get help in emergency situations.



Keep Fit, Keep Healthy

Reading

Children will participate in the Year 6 revision unit of SFA, consolidating and learning new reading and comprehension skills. Children will be sent home with an Accelerated Reader book which you should share with your child. They will take a test on their understanding when they have completed it.



Mathematics

This term the children will be continuing the Primary Advantage Maths programme with a focus on reasoning and problem solving, to deepen their conceptual understanding of place value in numbers of up to 10,000,000. We will revise all areas of the curriculum but will focus in particular on the following units of the maths curriculum:

- Roman Numerals
- Time
- Algebra
- Problem solving. This is the application process of all objectives covered over the term.

Writing

This half term we will be covering a variety of different genres including instructional writing and narrative writing. We will be revisiting different genres and will use whole texts to teach story writing and continue to look at shorter texts of different non fiction types. Weekly spellings based on patterns and strategies will be linked with handwriting.

Grammar will be taught both discretely and as part of stand alone lessons.

How can you help me at home?

Help me practise my times tables at speed. By the end of the term children should be confident with all their times tables up to 12x12.

Help me practise my spellings. Spelling tests will happen every Friday and a new set will be given to the children to take home for the following week.
