The children will learn about solving friendship problems and explore how they can help others to feel part of a group.

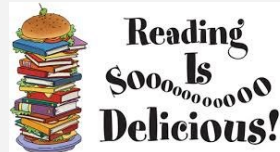
They will also explore the feelings that people experience due to bereavement or family circumstances changing.
