Children will discuss the similarities between all religious holidays celebrated at this time of year.

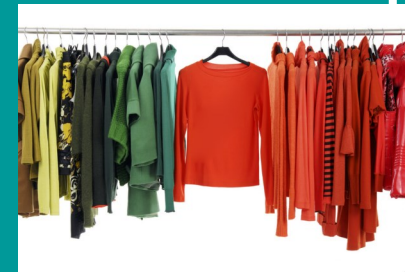
Please Remember

IPC Topic

Reading

Year 2 have made a great start with their new Reading Journals and we want to continue to encourage them to take ownership of their reading by writing their own comments.

Children have made fantastic progress on the Accelerated Reader scheme, all children should be aiming to move onto the scheme and meet their targets.



Writing

We will focus on writing explanation texts about different types of clothing. Children will also focus on learning the features of a persuasive text and then applying this to their own writing.

'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' by Judith Kerr will be the focus during Writing Weeks. Children will learn to retell the story using actions and puppets. Once children are familiar with the story they will write their own dilemma story.

Mathematics

Children will practise mental recall of number facts. They will be tested on these in their weekly 'Beat That!' tests.

In our 'Maths Meetings' we will practise strategies for answering questions that apply our learning in number, shape, space and measure.

During our maths lessons this term we will be learning:

- *Addition and subtraction word problems.*
- *Units of measure.*
- *Collecting and interpreting data.*
