Home learning will begin this half term— look at for the Reception Home Learning Passport for further information.



Literacy

During phonics I will be encouraged to hear the sounds in words and will learn which letters correspond to these sounds.

I will develop my understanding of stories by discussing the events, setting and characters.

I will practise forming letters correctly using a variety of media: sand trays, foam, paint, chalk, markers, crayons and pencils.

How can you help me at home?

Ask me what sound I have learnt today and encourage me to write the sound. Provide me with different writing tools and paper to write sentences, lists, notes and cards.

Communication and Language

I will be developing my explanation and questioning skills.

I will maintain attention and concentration by sitting quietly and listening to others during learning time.

I will use a range of writing tools and technology to express myself in words.

How can you help me at home?

Talk to me about the weather each day and the appropriate clothing needed.

Mathematics

This term in mathematics, I will continue developing my confidence and my competence around the concepts of shape, the calendar and positional language.

I will develop my counting skills and secure my understanding of the concept of one more and one less. We will continue practising our number formation as we build our confidence and understanding of the numbers 1-10.

How can you help me at home?

Play games involving number recognition and practise forming the numbers 1-10. Encourage me to say the number rhyme when forming my numbers.

IPC

Our IPC topic is 'Weather Wonders!'.

Our entry point will be listening to sounds of severe weather scenes and watching a video of a tornado taking place.

I will be learning about different types of weather and the suitable clothing needed.

I will observe different types of weather and record my observations using iPads, graphs and charts. I will make comparisons.
