Writing

"I want My Hat Back" by Jon Klassen will be the focus text for Year One during Writing Weeks, at the end of term. Children will learn to retell the story using actions, pictures and puppets. Once children are familiar with the story they will create their own versions of the book.

We will focus on story writing, using story patterns. We will learn how to write our own stories with a beginning, middle and an end.

Mathematics

In Autumn 2, we will be focusing on shapes and patterns.

Children will learn to identify, sort and classify 2D and 3D shapes. We will learn how to describe the properties of shapes.

We will be making repeated patterns using 2D and 3D shapes. We will use positional language to describe patterns and follow instructions.

We will also use positional language to programme a floor toy.
