Religious Education

In R.E children will be learning about Christian Christmas Story. They will learn how it is celebrated and some of the key beliefs of this festival, for example how the story is about birth but also hope. The children will be encouraged to reflect on their own lives and explore their personal experiences about the Christmas story and how it compares to the original story.

IPC Topic

Our topic is Scavengers and Settlers. The children will develop their knowledge and understanding of the people and cultures of the Stone, Bronze and Iron ages. In History we will learn the skills necessary to be able to give reasons for changes and events. In Science we will investigate which materials are best for hunting and digging. In Geography we will develop our skills in using an atlas. In International, we will be learning how to research and assess communication skills in early cultures.

Reading

We expect 3 comments each week in the children's reading journals.

Children will choose an Accelerated Reader book to read at school and home. Once finished, they will complete a test on the class i-pads. Then children will choose a class reader or a book of interest.

Children will have daily SFA lessons, learning new reading and comprehension skills as well as developing co-operative learning strategies.

Mathematics

This term the children will begin with 3-4 week unit learning addition and subtraction number skills with up to 4 digits.

The children will then learn about length and perimeter for ten sessions.

At the end of the term the children will be learning the skills needed to solve multiplication and division word problems.

Writing

The content of the children's writing will be linked to our IPC 'Topic Scavengers and Settlers.

Children will be developing non-fiction by writing instructions which tell you how to make something, and then explanations which explain how or why something has happened.

The term will end with Writing weeks using Leon and the Place Between by Graham Baker Smith as a stimulus.
