Literacy

During phonics I will be encouraged to hear the sounds in words and will learn which letters correspond to these sounds.

I will be beginning Daily Supported Reading in which an adult will be helping me to decode a story each day.

I will continue to practise forming letters correctly using a variety of media and begin to link the sound to the letter name.

How can you help me at home?

Ask me what sound I have learnt today and encourage me to write the sound. Provide me with different writing tools and paper to write sentences, lists, notes and cards.

Communication and Language

I will be using my experience of the world to answer 'how' and 'why' questions in response to stories and events.

I will demonstrate that I can listen attentively in a range of situations, whilst engaged in my learning activities.

I will use a range of writing tools and technology to express myself in words.

How can you help me at home?

Talk to me about the dinosaurs we are learning about, discuss their features.

Mathematics

This term in mathematics, I will be developing my understanding of numbers up to 15 then to 20 and the relationships between them. I will continue to practice my number formation as I do so.

I will then further my knowledge and understanding of shape and pattern, exploring and identifying both 2D and 3D shapes.

How can you help me at home?

Play games involving counting and number recognition. Encourage me to practice my formation with a range of media.

Point out numbers around the house and when we go out.

IPC

Our IPC topic is 'Dinosaur Detectives!'.

Our entry point will be investigating the mystery eggs that appeared in our classroom over the holidays and predicting their contents.

I will be learning about different types of dinosaur and sorting them into categories.

I will also be learning investigative skills and applying them to the natural world.
