Dear Year 2 Families

End of Key Stage 1 SATs

As I am sure you are aware, we are required by the Department of Education to submit assessment levels for our Year 2 children at the end of the academic year. In order to make these judgements, the class teachers use both the work the children have completed in their books and 'End of Key Stage Assessments', known as SATs.

This year, these tests will be completed by the children during the first two weeks of May. There are two short reading papers and two short maths papers for each child to complete, one focused on arithmetic and one on reasoning. The children take these assessments in small groups outside the classroom either with their class teacher or a senior leader. We make the assessments as straightforward as possible and will explain to the children that they provide them with the opportunity to share their knowledge and show off all the hard work and excellent learning that they have done this year.
