Dear KS2 Families,

This academic year we are trialling a new and exciting way for our Key Stage Two children to access their home learning tasks, through an online platform called Google Classroom.

Google Classroom is a virtual classroom, managed by our own administrators, where teachers can create assignments, share materials and communicate with their students. Many of the teachers in Key Stage Two regularly use Google Classroom as a way to share materials to the class. This already allows for a greater choice and dramatically saves on paper and photocopying.

Your child's maths, spelling and 'maker mat' projects will now be set weekly within your child's class on Google Classroom. They will be able to access this on a device connected to the internet by going to classroom.google.com and signing in with a unique username and password that we provide for them. Furthermore, with Google Classroom, we are able to invite guardians to receive weekly summary emails that allow you to see the class activity.

In order to provide you with more information about this, our teachers will allocate some time during our 'Meet The Teacher' events this week to discuss what this will look like for your child's home learning.
