Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are delighted to announce our Christmas Card Project which we are undertaking in partnership with Art Projects for Schools Ltd ([www.apfs.org.uk](http://www.apfs.org.uk)).

The funds raised through your support will be used towards the children going to the Christmas Pantomime. Importantly, the cards also recognise and celebrate your child's creative effort and are great to send to family and friends.

All you need to do is ask/help your child create a piece of artwork on A4 paper, any paper/card can be used and it can be decorated using anything except glitter (pen/ink/paint/cotton wool/buttons/material etc). You then need to hand the artwork into **RECEPTION** by **THURSDAY 18<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2017**, with your child's name and class written on the back of the artwork.

**We will also be selecting one design to use as the Grazebrook School Winter Fair Poster!**

The artwork will then be scanned by APFS and after half term you will get the details of how to go online to review the artwork and then order the cards online (you will also be able to personalise your items with your child's name and/or school, create your own custom greetings, and pay securely by debit or credit card). Orders will need to be placed online by **6th NOVEMBER 2017** and will then be sent out by 19<sup>th</sup> November 2017, in plenty of time to write and send your cards.

The artwork your child has created will be accurately reproduced in full colour onto Christmas cards that are available in packs of 12. Additional items are also available such as packs of 6 larger gloss coated luxury Christmas cards, packs of 3 sheets of wrapping paper and packs of 12 folded gift tags. The quality of reproduction is excellent as is the quality of the cards; samples are available to view at the school office.
