KEY VOCABULARY

COMPASS	A INSTRUMENT CONTAINING AN MAGNAZIED POINTER THAT SHOWS THE DIRECTION OF NORTH, AND BARINGS FROM IT.
EQUATOR	A IMAGINARY LINE DRAWN ON THE EARTH AND SPACED EQUALLY BETWEEN THE NORTH AND SOUTH POLE.
HEMISPHERE	THIS MEANS HALF OF A SPHERE, WHICH MEANS HALF OF THE EARTH. THE EARTH IS SPLIT INTO THE NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN HEMISPHERES.
SETTLEMENT	A PLACE WHERE PEOPLE LIVE. A SETTLEMENT CAN BE AS SMALL AS A HOUSE, OR AS LARGE AS A MEGA CITY.
KEY	A LIST OF SIGNS, COLOUR AND SYMBOLS USED ON A MAP TO EXPLAIN WHAT THEY MEAN.
REGION	AN AREA OF LAND THAT SHARES COMMON GEOGRAPHICAL FEATURES.
