Dear Year 6 families,

We hope you are all well and would like you to know that we are very much here for you while the school is closed to all except for key worker and vulnerable pupils. Duncan Kilty will be your main point of contact as the phase leader for Upper Key Stage 2.

### **Year 6 Google Classroom**

While the school is closed, we will be using Google Classroom to post home learning and Google Meet links to your child each day. If you have any difficulties logging in please let us know and we will do the best we can to support you with this.

### **Pupil Ipads**

As detailed in the letter you received yesterday, all year 6 families have been invited to come to school to collect the ipads that have been allocated to individual pupils between 1:30 and 2:15 today. It is very important that you come to school to collect an ipad if your child will find it difficult to access the home learning without this device.

### **Home Learning**

As there will be some pupils in school, Mr Zanier will teach the children that are in school while Ms Bratt will communicate with the children who are at home. Each day, there will be a morning message from Ms Bratt posted by 9am. This will be used to say hello and explain the learning for the day. We will also share a timetable with you to help structure the day. Each day, a reading, maths and curriculum assignment will be posted. The curriculum assignments will cover a range of subjects eg. science, history, PSHE, art etc. Across the week, specialist teachers will post lessons and assemblies in music, art and Spanish.

### **Video Calls**

We will arrange small group video lessons with your child during each day which will give them the chance to learn with a familiar adult and some of their friends. As mentioned above, these lessons will primarily be with Ms Bratt as Mr Zanier will be teaching the pupils that are in school but Mr Zanier will be involved where possible. The focus of these sessions will be shared in advance.
